





### Preparing the meter



Slide the sensor cover to the left as far as it will go. Meter will turn on.



## Insert cassette, rounded end first and press flat. Close sensor cover.






### 5 Insert lancet and twist off the cap

### Setting the time & date Silvideo 1


Hold down the S button to enter the settings menu (alternatively, connect to the app to set the time & date automatically)



Meter may show 'exp' (cassette expired) if the correct date is not set.



Press M to change the flashing character. Press S to save.











Press depth selector firmly against selected puncture site, then press S\*





- Gently squeeze out a small round drop of blood.
- Keep the palm of your hand facing down.
- Use immediately. Do not allow the drop to run, dry or spread.









Do not spread blood off the edge of the tape and onto the meter.

Do not smear a small drop across the test zone. A larger drop should be used.







Close the sensor cover. The meter will turn off.

NOTE: If you close the cover before winding the used test away E-3 will be displayed - open the cover and wind

Clean sensor window with a damp cotton tip or tissue in the direction shown.



### **Key to Common Error Messages**

E-3	Used test not wound into waste chamber. Open sensor cover and wind away
	the used test.
<b>E-4</b>	Blood applied too early or Sensor window dirty. Wait for blood drop icon before applying blood or clean meter.
E-5	Sensor window dirty or too much direct sunlight. Clean the meter or move to shade.
	Cassette wound too far. Continue winding until meter says "OK".
[一]	Insufficient blood. Use a larger drop or press down on the drop to spread it.
E-9	Test zone error or Sensor window dirty. Clean the sensor window and repeat
	the test. Expired cassette.
exp  exp  exp	Cassette past expiry date or opened longer than 90 days or date set in meter is a future date - check year.
